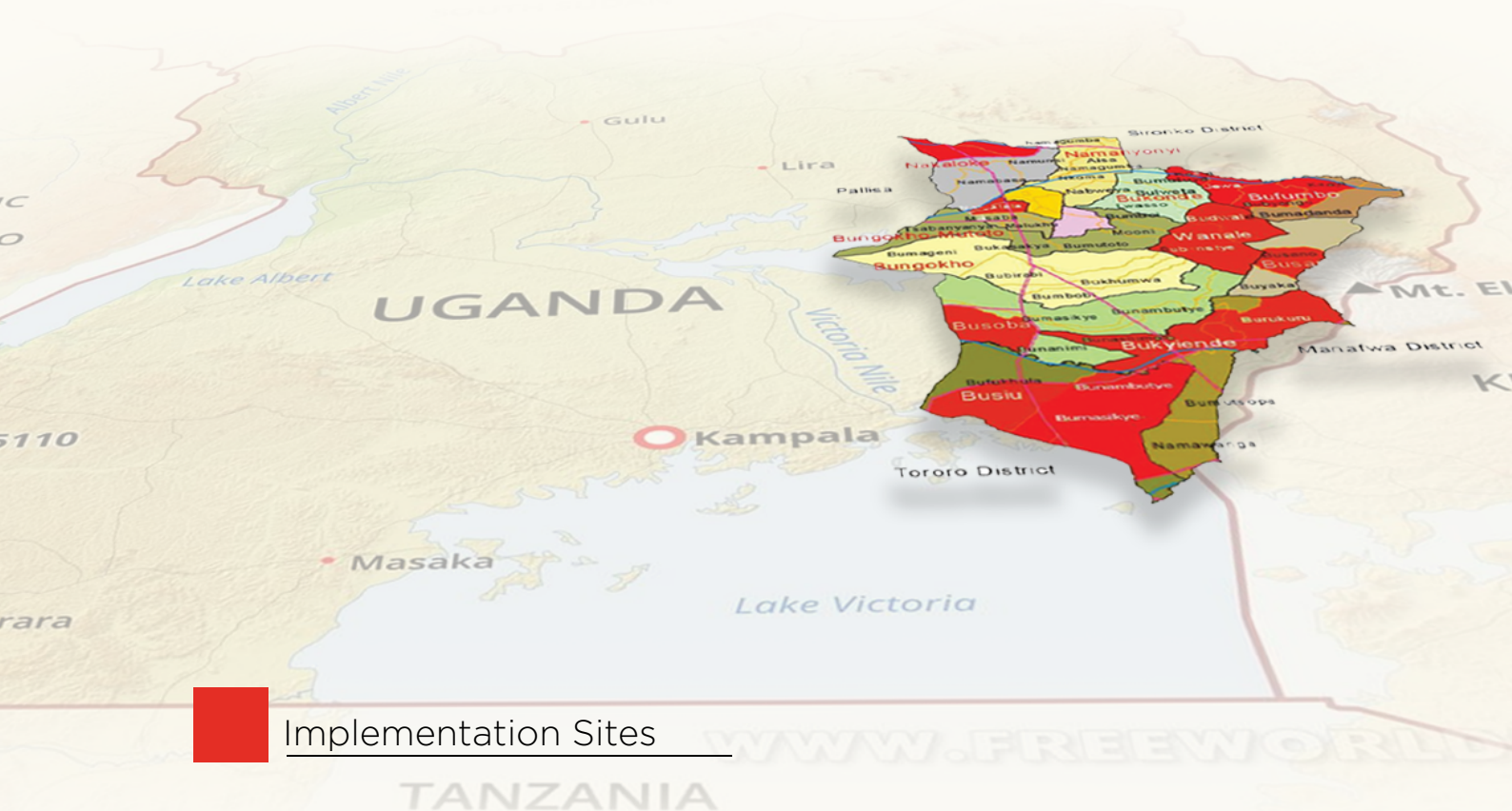
ORGANIZATION PROFILE

Mbale Network of Young People Living with HIV/AIDS (MNYPA) is a dynamic, youth-led organization dedicated to improving the lives of young people living with and affected by HIV in Bugisu sub region and beyond. Established in 2017,

MNYPA has grown into a leading force for advocacy, service delivery, and youth empowerment. In 2024 alone, we reached 18,261 young people (11,271 females and 6,990 males) with life-changing interventions in HIV prevention, SRHR, gender-based violence response, and economic empowerment.

Our work is driven by data, innovation, and partnerships to create sustainable impact. With a strong network of community-based structures, MNYPA ensures that young people have access to quality health services, education, and opportunities for economic resilience.
